In Toddler room next week our theme is Mothers Day! During the week we will be talking to the children about their mums and what mums do to help us, we will be looking at our 'all about me' book (if you haven't sent any pictures for this - it's not too late!) and creating some special Mothers Day crafts too!

In **Lower Pre-school** next week the children will be making lots of music and listening to different sounds, Katharine will be bringing in her guitar, the children will be looking at different ranges of sound including big and small sounds.

In **Upper Pre-school** we will be preparing their Mother's Day surprises. We will also be talking about what we look like and feelings

What have we been up to?

Babies have loved creating some daffodil pictures this week using Spring colours and collage effects, our hands always get very sticky from the glue but mess it what we do best!

We have been seeing lots of friendly behaviour and sharing from our older children towards our younger children this week and we continue to encourage this.

We have been particularly enjoying the the garden and the warmer weather this week, and this has meant we could do lots more messy play activities outdoors - this week we had cooked spaghetti which was very sticky and great for fine manipulative skills and co-ordination!

This week in **Toddlers**, we spent a good period of time outside exploring our revamped garden, the sandpit has been a big hit! On Monday we talked about St David's day; we celebrated by having a giant daffodil in the tray which we added tissue paper and lolly sticks to and tried to match the colours. We also painted our very own Welsh flags too!

On Thursday we celebrated World book day by reading all of our favourite books and we loved seeing the children dressed up as their favourite book characters! The rest of the week we have focused on shapes, triangles, squares, circles, hearts and stars! We have done shape matching, finding shapes in the environment and we even fed some hungry shapes too!

In **Lower Pre-school** this week the children have loved exploring the new mud kitchen, they have filled up pots and pans and even done their own washing up! In the room the children have been looking at different labels and signs, filling out checklist and matching labels to the contents of boxes.

This week in **Upper Pre-school** the children have been very busy in the mud kitchen, they used different tools to transfer mud and made their own mud pies! Our cooking activity of the week was soup, the children talked about the different vegetables they used and how they were preparing them ready to cook. On Monday, we celebrated St David's day by making daffodils. The children really enjoyed colour mixing in the tough tray.
