### Reminders and News

- If your child displays any symptoms of COVID 19 (continuous cough OR a temperature OR loss of taste or smell- more information can be found at [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk)) or if they are unwell and you are unsure whether they should be attending nursery or require any medication, please DO NOT bring them to nursery. Please contact Carly or Paige before coming to nursery and they will advise you on what steps you should take. Children with COVID symptoms, as explained above, will need to be tested or isolate at home for 10 days and cannot return until the isolation period has expired, or we have had confirmation of a negative test result. If your child displays symptoms whilst at nursery, we will contact parents/guardians and request for them to be collected immediately and to be tested before returning to nursery. If your child still displays symptoms after a negative result, please ensure to keep your child at home until they are clear of all symptoms. If your child is suffering from a temperature (and you have had COVID ruled out through testing), please ensure your child is 24 hours clear of a temperature before they return to the nursery setting.

Some of the activities the children have really enjoyed are paint balloon pop and making oat biscuits.

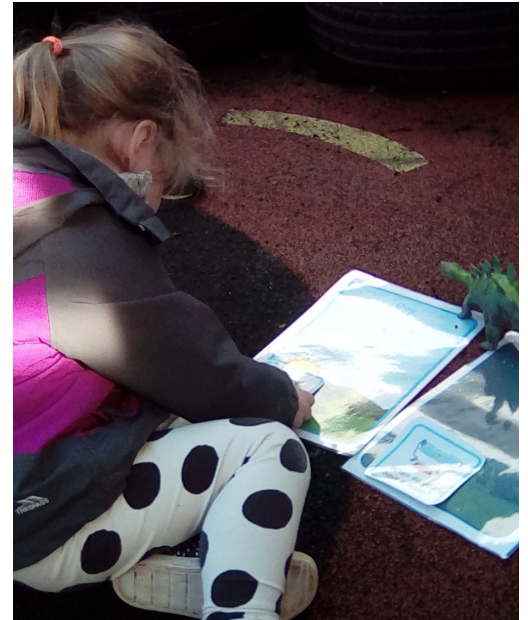
This week we have celebrated a lot of birthdays at nursery with cake and music- Happy Birthday to everyone that had a birthday!
