Baby Centre- This week in we have been searching for animals that relate to spring, in a game planned by our key carers, such as lambs, chicks, and rabbits- we enjoyed looking around the baby centre for pictures of Spring animals! We also created an animal hunt in the garden and then enjoyed exploring them in some colourful gloop and a messy play tuff tray.



Hedgehogs- This week in Hedgehogs we have been planting seeds, counting the seeds as we put them in the soil and learning about quantity. We have also been practicing using tools for a purpose, such as using a spade to transfer the soil into plant pots.

Pre-school- This week we have been exploring the theme of growth and life cycles of flowers for spring. We have made marks with daffodils, counted seeds and matched them to numerals, planted cress and gone on a local flower hunt
