What have we been up to?

Babies – Babies have had a fantastic week this week and they have created some lovely artwork for their summertime board, as well as exploring the sand and water trays, creating a real summer vibe within the room! They have also been practising their sign of the week 'please'.

Toddlers – This week in Toddlers we have had a fantastic time celebrating Summertime! We have had a flour/water tuff tray and even a shaving foam/sand ice-cream! It's been a very messy week as always, we are glad the sun came back out to play too!

Lower Pre-School - This week 'Neon Leon' has been our focus story, it is the story of a chameleon who didn't fit in until he found his own orange covered environment; this lead us to explore different environments, with different textures, colours, prints and patterns, we matched animals and insects to the environment, we also discussed the differences we all have and being inclusive to all.

In our messy area we have been stamping and printing, we used large sheets of bubble wrap and covered them in paint and then printed it on to paper.

We have also had multi-coloured playdough and we have been looking at different patterns that can be made in the playdough using the different toys and resources.

Upper Pre-School – This week we have been focusing on making relationships, writing and being imaginative. We have been very busy this week! Our theme has been animals and throughout the week we have been taking part in lots of activities around our focuses and theme. On Monday we used paint to create our letters of our name using our fingers. The book of the week has been dear zoo. We made our own zoo and recreated the story using our props.

As part of our school readiness we have been talking about the different schools we will be attending from September and dressing up in school uniforms

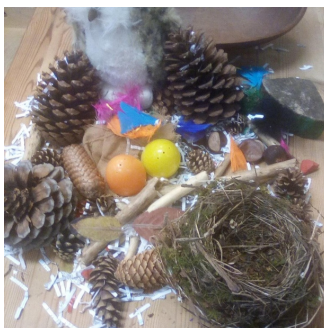
Upcoming Events
