What have we been up to?

Baby Centre- This week in our Baby Centre, we have been thoroughly enjoying activities that support our physical development and that correspond with Cooking Week. We have been able to climb on soft play, explore the garden and use a variety of tools within our water play to empty and fill. Throughout cooking week, we have been able to learn some new vocabulary such as bake, pat, mix and pour. Some of our babies have shown great skill in developing their speech as they were able to repeat these singular words to then use independently.

Hedgehogs- This week in Hedgehog's, following on from our health and hygiene week, we have been learning to cook healthy treats. We have been looking at oral health a little further and tied this in with cooking week. Hedgehogs have been able to use tools to make tasty but healthy treats such as fruit kebabs, homemade pizzas and much more. Hedgehogs have been learning about the importance of teeth brushing and going to the dentist.

Pre-school- This week in Pre-school, we have been learning about sequencing and following directions. Pre-school have been able to show great skill in following directions and being able to sequence together how to make each recipe. We will continue to support the children's interest in cooking week by cooking regularly and creating our own recipes. Reminders

- Please ensure your child has suitable clothing for the weather ahead of their session, so they are able to make full use of the activities and facilities provided. Including wellington boots, rain coats etc.
- Please remember, if you are showing symptoms and/or are awaiting test results for COVID 19; please do not come to the nursery to drop your child off.
- Drop off/Collection-Please ensure you are dropping and collecting your child at the correct session times. Ratios are organised accordingly, and you may be at risk of being asked to wait if you are too early for your child's session or a late fee may be applied to your account.
- Label clothing-Please ensure all your child's belongings are clearly labelled to lower the risk of missing items.
- COVID-19- If you are double vaccinated or under the age of 18, post two weeks from your vaccination, and you experience any signs or symptoms, you will no longer have isolate. However, your child will require to get a PCR test if they display any signs or symptoms whilst at nursery. We would be very grateful, if you have been in contact with someone who tests positive, to make a member of staff or management aware so that we can be extra vigilant and monitor for any signs and symptoms.
- Prescribed medication- Please ensure all prescribed medication has been given for a minimum of 24 hours/ 4 doses before returning to nursery. We can give medication as long as the labelled medication is provided, and it is signed in each day.
