What have we been up to?

Babies – This week in baby room our sign of the week has been 'sorry'. Our theme throughout the week has been managing feelings and behaviour and we incorporated this into our play by encouraging the children to share and take turns. They have done so well and we will keep persevering with this throughout the next few weeks.

Toddlers – This week in Toddlers we have had a focus theme of fine motor skills and the children have showed perseverance and determination throughout the week. We have had activities out such as threading straws and spaghetti through holes in a box, threading laces through animal pictures and picking up small objects with the children's tweezers- all of which develop fine motor skills. We have also enjoyed the weather and have been making the most of it! We have enjoyed having out water play and we discussed the importance of wearing sun cream and our hats!

Lower Pre-school & Upper Pre-school - This week we have been focusing on the world and physical development. Throughout the week we have been practicing our ball skills by playing lots of group ball games. We have also been exploring our world around us by looking at our bug hotel in the garden and discussing what the different bugs we found look like. Our adults have planned lots of fun activities throughout our week. On Tuesday we focused on health and self-care where we bathed our babies using bubble bath and shaving foam. We discussed our health and self-care routines at home and in preschool. On Wednesday we enjoyed our room on the broom inspired tray; which was our book of the week. We used the characters from the book and natural resources from the garden to recreate the story.

Babies – Next week Emma will be joining our baby room team, Emma holds a level 4 in childcare and education. Next week our sign of the week will be 'more'. We will be having a summer theme next week – enjoying water play and making ice creams from craft materials

Toddlers – Next week our focus theme is gross motor skills. We will be concentrating on being able to confidently move around the nursery in a variety of ways. We will also be using the book 'we're going on a bear hunt' to help us look at different ways to move through a variety of sensory areas.

Lower and Upper pre-school – Next week we will be focusing on people and communities and our role play area will be changing into a doctors surgery. The theme of the week will be dinosaurs. Throughout the week we will be having dinosaur hunts, dinosaur mark making and much more! Our book of the week will be a book focusing on starting school. We will be having lots of fun child led activities and games as it is the last week before the summer holidays starts for some of our children.
