What have we been up to?

0-18 months – Buttercups

Our Buttercups enjoyed creating their own puppet show with animal hand puppets this week, which encouraged social skills and communication development. The babies also looked intently at how the animal's mouths opened and closed and they loved listening to the different noises that they made. We are going to follow on from this and create our own puppet show out of a box, to be explored in for circle times. We have also been working on our motor skills and created a ring stacker from a mug holder, we have been carefully putting rings onto the different holders and this kept us engaged for a long period of time; we are going to follow on from this and paint the cup holders different colours and try to match the different coloured rings onto the holder.

18 months-30 months old – Bluebells

This week in Bluebells we have welcome a new friend and Bluebells have welcomed our new friend in with welcoming arms and happy faces, which shows great social skills. We have really enjoyed different types of role play activities this week, particularly with dolls, potties and nappies. Bluebells have continued to talk about the butterflies that we released last week and following on from this we created our own butterflies and discovered a new way of painting using spray bottles and worked on our motor skills to spray the paint out of the bottle and onto the paper- this was so much fun! We have displayed our spray painted butterflies into our room and love seeing our masterpieces hanging up proudly.

2 years -5 year old room – Sunflower

This week Sunflowers enjoyed a variety of physical activities. We enjoyed a dodge ball game where staff played against the children! The children loved catching the staff out, we also enjoyed a number of football games in the garden using our new football goal and balls. This week we have created our own treasure maps and have been hunting for treasure that our teachers have hid. The children also helped to build up their imagination skills and made up stories using their treasure maps.

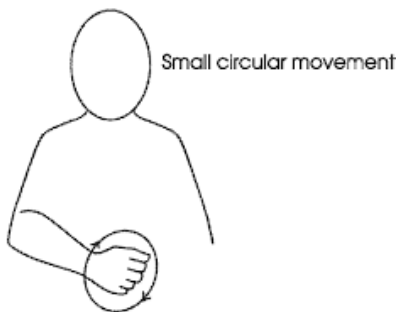


SCHOOL LEAVERS 2021
