What have we been up to?

Babies – This week in the baby room our sign of the week has been 'cold'. We have used paint dobbers to create different marks in our tray, had a lentil messy tray created into a poppy shape and also had a water tray with petals in for our way of participating in Remembrance day.

Toddlers – This week in Toddlers we have been doing lots of Remembrance Day crafts and activities. We had a red water tray with petals in and used pipettes and cups to play with the water. As part of our Remembrance celebrations our Toddlers also joined in with the Cbeebies broadcast of Poppies, this helped to engage the children during the 2 minutes silence.

Pre-School - This week we have looked at the phonics sound 'jugglers juggling j,j,j'. At circle time we talked about our firework experiences from Friday and over the weekend, following on from the children's interest we created firework and bonfire pictures. We also had a painted 'fire' created in our tuff tray which the children used water spray bottles to put out! Our Pre-schoolers created Poppies using tissue paper and paint and were all encouraged to join in with the 2 minutes silence.

Covid 19

If you are double vaccinated (14 days post your 2nd vaccine) or under the age of 18, and you are in contact with someone that tests positive, you will no longer have to isolate. However, your child will require a PCR test if they live with someone that tests positive or if they display any signs or symptoms, before returning to nursery. We would be very grateful that if you or your child have been in contact with someone who tests positive, to make a member of staff or management aware so that we can be extra vigilant and monitor for any signs and symptoms.

If we get 3 or more positive cases within a bubble, the whole bubble will be asked to isolate for 72 hours before getting a PCR test (all negative results will need to be emailed to a member of the management team)

We will do everything we can to avoid any disruption to our families, and we are working tirelessly to keep COVID out of the nursery so please be extra vigilant to symptoms, get your child tested if you are not sure and please be honest with our staff.
